

STANDING RULES GOVERNING SCHOLARSHIPS
(As revised May, 2004)

THE PHYLLIS V. ROBERTS SCHOLARSHIP

The Scholarship is named for Phyllis V. Roberts, the second Virginian to serve as President of GFWC, 1986-88. The Phyllis V. Roberts Scholarship Fund shall consist of contributions from clubs and individuals given for the purpose of awarding scholarships to college graduates in a subject field selected by each administration. The 2010-2012 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate student in the field of Social Work, whose goal is to work with victims of family violence. The Scholarship Committee will administer the scholarship fund.

1. Applicant must be a Virginia resident.
2. Letters of reference from three (3) individuals – one of a general nature, two recommendations from recent professors – must accompany the application.
3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 undergraduate GPA verified by statement from undergraduate college accompanying application.
4. Applicant shall include a short statement of their reason for choosing a graduate degree in Social Work with a goal to work with victims of family violence.
5. Applicant should include a resume of educational and employment history as well as community service and awards received.

Scholarships totaling \$3,000 may be given during 2010-2012. A scholarship of \$1,000 per year may be awarded each recipient. A recipient may re-apply. All monies will be paid directly to the Virginia College/University, where the student attends, after receipt of verification that the applicant is a registered student.
