

### **THE PHYLLIS V. ROBERTS SCHOLARSHIP**

The Scholarship is named for Phyllis V. Roberts, the second Virginian to serve as President of GFWC, 1986-88. The Phyllis V. Roberts Scholarship Fund shall consist of contributions from clubs and individuals given for the purpose of awarding scholarships to college graduates in a subject field selected by each administration. The 2016-2018 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate student in the field of Food Science/Nutritional Science, whose goal is to work in the field of Human Nutrition or Nutritional Science or Food Science, while helping to address food insecurity in our communities. The Scholarship Committee will administer the scholarship fund.

1. Applicant must be a Virginia resident.
2. Letters of reference from three (3) individuals – one of a general nature, two recommendations from recent professors – must accompany the application.
3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 undergraduate GPA verified by statement from undergraduate college accompanying application.
4. Applicant shall include a short statement of their reason for choosing a graduate degree in the field of Food Science/Nutritional Science, whose goal is to work in the field of Human Nutrition or Nutritional Science or Food Science, while helping to address food insecurity in our communities.
5. Applicant should include a resume of educational and employment history as well as community service and awards received.

Scholarships totaling \$3,000 may be given during 2016-2018. A scholarship of \$1,000 per year may be awarded each recipient. A recipient may re-apply. All monies will be paid directly to the Virginia College/University, where the student attends, after receipt of verification that the applicant is a registered student.
